The Vermont State Colleges Student Association (VSCSA) is an organization made up of all students enrolled in any of the Vermont State Colleges: *Lyndon State, Castleton State, Johnson State, Vermont Technical, and Community College of Vermont*. The purpose of the organization is to foster unity between the students and the five colleges, to represent and advocate for the rights and interests of the students, and to provide information about student education issues. Three representatives from each of the five Vermont State Colleges serve on the VSCSA Board of Directors.

Leadership Scholarship Requirements:

1. Applicants must be attending one of the Vermont State Colleges during the 2013-2014 academic year and be returning for 2014-2015.
2. Applicants must hold a minimum 2.5 grade point average.
3. Applicants must complete an official VSCSA Leadership Scholarship application. A complete application packet will include:
 - A complete application
 - 2 Letters of Reference, including contact information, which document the applicant's college and community leadership experience
 - An essay from 250-500 words describing the importance of student leadership
4. Applications and all required materials must be typed or word-processed.

Applications missing any of the required elements will NOT be considered.

The complete application must be **postmarked no later than April 14, 2014**.
