Review, Investigation, and Resolution

CCV will support any complainant or respondent in understanding how to navigate the complaint processes. In general, CCV, after consultation with a complainant, will follow the [implementing Procedures](#) for [VSC Policy 311-A: Sexual Misconduct, Domestic Violence, Dating Violence, and Stalking](#). The College may refer the matter for investigation. At the conclusion of the investigation, disciplinary action may be sought using the Policy 311-A implementing Procedures.

CCV will not tolerate retaliation and will take immediate and responsive action to any report of retaliation or any violation of protective interim measures.
