As most of you are aware, we are working with the Vermont Department of Health, which is closely monitoring the development of the Coronavirus (COVID-19), to ensure that we are taking every precaution possible to support the health and safety of our faculty, students, and staff. In addition, we are paying close attention to the revised recommendations of the Center for Disease Control (CDC).

As a result, the College has begun taking action to implement a facilities step-down plan to further protect the wellness of our learning community. Beginning tomorrow (March 18), the majority of our staff will transition to working remotely. I want to assure you that our priority remains supporting you and your students as you complete the semester. To that end, we will continue to provide access to computer and internet resources at the center-level for faculty on an appointment-only basis.

We expect that some students will struggle with access issues, and we are working to develop plans for supporting them. CCV's response team continues to meet every morning to discuss the evolving situation, and we will reassess our facilities step-down plan on April 3<sup>rd</sup>.
