## Earn Extra Money for Your Trip to the Farmers Market!

**Summer Crop Cash** is an incentive dollar that is earned for 3SquaresVT /SNAP purchases for use on the future purchase of fresh fruits, vegetables, herbs, seeds, and starts at the market. You can turn \$10 of your 3SquaresVT dollars into \$20 in food every time you visit the farmers market.

## Virtual Mental Health & Recovery Resources

Staying well during times of high stress is most important so you can keep working and take care of family and friends. There are ways to continue to access affordable mental health services virtually through tele-medicine and technology.

## Pandemic Electronic Benefit Transfer (P-EBT)

Households with eligible children will receive a benefit of \$387.60 per eligible child. If eligible, your household should have received benefits in late May. These benefits may be used to buy eligible food items anywhere 3SquaresVT is accepted and are active for one year from the date of issuance. ## BE COUNTED!

There is still time to take the 2020 Census survey. It only takes a few minutes and is important for Vermont. The data collected is used to determine for the next ten years how federal funds will be allocated to Vermont communities for public services, schools, hospitals, and infrastructure projects among many other things. It is vitally important that everyone gets counted for Vermont to receive its share of these federal funds. It's simple, short and safe!
