

CCV TRIO Student Support Services Program Application & Enrollment Form, 2020-2021

Our goal is to provide individualized support to eligible students seeking to complete an Associate Degree, Certificate, or to transfer to a four-year school within a four-year timeframe.

As a participant in CCV's TRIO Student Support Services Program, you will engage in the following benefits:

- An intensive advising relationship with your TRIO SSS Advisor who will serve as your academic mentor, advisor, transfer counselor, career counselor, and resource consultant
- Connection with a TRIO SSS Coach who regularly checks in about current classes and needs
- Access to the TRIO SSS Canvas course where you will find resources and make connections to TRIO students statewide.
- Assistance with Financial Aid forms and Financial Literacy resources
- Opportunity to request additional one-on-one or small-group tutoring
- Possible eligibility to receive TRIO SSS grants
- Eligibility to apply for study abroad scholarships
- Eligibility to participate in TRIO's Tech-to-Go (technology lending) program
- Participation in CCV TRIO's Annual Leadership Day and other leadership opportunities
- Participation in TRIO events including transfer campus visits, workshops/webinars, and presentations

The information you provide is strictly confidential and is necessary for reporting purposes as well as eligibility determination. Completion of this application does not guarantee acceptance into the CCV TRIO program; **admission is a privilege as we are limited to serving 225 students when over 4,500 CCV students are eligible.**

The selection process also includes an interview with a TRIO SSS Advisor. While the TRIO SSS Program is designed to help students succeed in college, it takes a **strong commitment on the part of the student** to be truly effective. **Ideal candidates are committed to completing their CCV Certificate or Associate Degree in four years, with additional consideration given to students who also plan to transfer to a 4-year college post CCV graduation.** *Each TRIO SSS student's individual performance impacts the entire program; therefore, each TRIO SSS student must agree to act responsibly and to be accountable for attainment of educational goals. CCV's Student Support Services TRIO program is federally funded under the Department of Education.*
