Dear CCV community,

Regrettably, today we learned that a member of our CCV-Winooski learning community has tested positive for COVID-19.

Upon learning of the result, we consulted Vermont Department of Health (DoH). The DoH is responsible for contact tracing and will notify anyone who needs to be informed. Based on the information available, the DoH does *not* believe this person was infectious when they attended class early last week.

At this time, there is no identified elevated risk for our community.

I recognize that this message brings unsettling news during a stressful time. I want to assure you that CCV is following our [established procedures](#) and the guidance provided by the Department of Health. I'm proud of the cooperation CCV students and employees have demonstrated during these past few months, maintaining vigilance and adhering to our protocols to keep each other safe. Please continue to do your part to support the health and safety of those in our academic centers and surrounding communities by following these guidelines:

Wear a mask.

Stay at least six feet from others.

Wash your hands often.

Stay home if you are experiencing any COVID symptoms.

Comply with Governor Scott's COVID [executive orders](#), amended November 13, 2020.
