

Champlain College Online

Fully online undergraduate and graduate certificate and degree programs attracting students from 50 states and 22 countries. Average student age is 36. Majority of courses are 7 week accelerated courses.

Curriculum and assignments are designed for adult learners, to use the workplace as a learning lab to test and apply concepts in a real world environment.

Champlain College Online (CCO)

CCO programs were designed with adult transfer students in mind.

Completer Programs are an option in some degrees, which allows students to directly apply their full 60 credits from their Associate degree to our Bachelor's degrees. Popular CCO programs among CCV alumni include:

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Transfer Credit Evaluation

Maximizing transfer credit

All transfer applicants are required to submit official transcripts of their high school and college records.

Admissions decisions are sent to students along with summary of transfer credit evaluation.

Courses are transferred in that fulfill requirements for their incoming Champlain program. Judgment of similarity is made to ensure alignment and student success with upper level courses.

Additional opportunities for earning potential transfer credit include CCV APL Transcript, CLEP, High School AP Credits, military transcripts.

Champlain College Online will accept select industry certifications that can be documented and validated by ACE or NCCRS.

Transfer Policies

C grade or higher on eligible transfer courses

Courses are eligible if taken at **regionally accredited** institutions (like CCV)

Maximum of 75 transfer credits for **on campus programs**

Maximum of 90 transfer credits for **online programs**
