Partnership Policy

- Community College of Vermont (CCV) Graduates are guaranteed acceptance into Goddard college
- Those who complete an associate degree at CCV, and who have been accepted for admission into Goddard, enter with the equivalent of 60 Goddard credits
- CCV, graduates will be issued a \$1000 Partnership Grant if they enroll.
