COMBINED BACHELOR'S/MASTER'S DEGREE

SUNY Empire State College students accepted into the combined bachelor's/master's degree program will take specified master's level courses during their bachelor's degree at the undergraduate rate and have them count towards their degree.

Current students should have a minimum of **60 credits completed** (enrolled at least one term at SUNY Empire) and a minimum **3.2 GPA**. The combined programs leading to MBA in Business Management, requires 148 credits total, of which 36 are master's credits leading to the MBA in Business Management. Students must meet all college, Area Of Study, and relevant concentration guidelines. (Bachelor's/junior year will apply for grad/accept as grad/take 12 grad credits as undergrad, then Master's will be only 24 credits depending on degree).

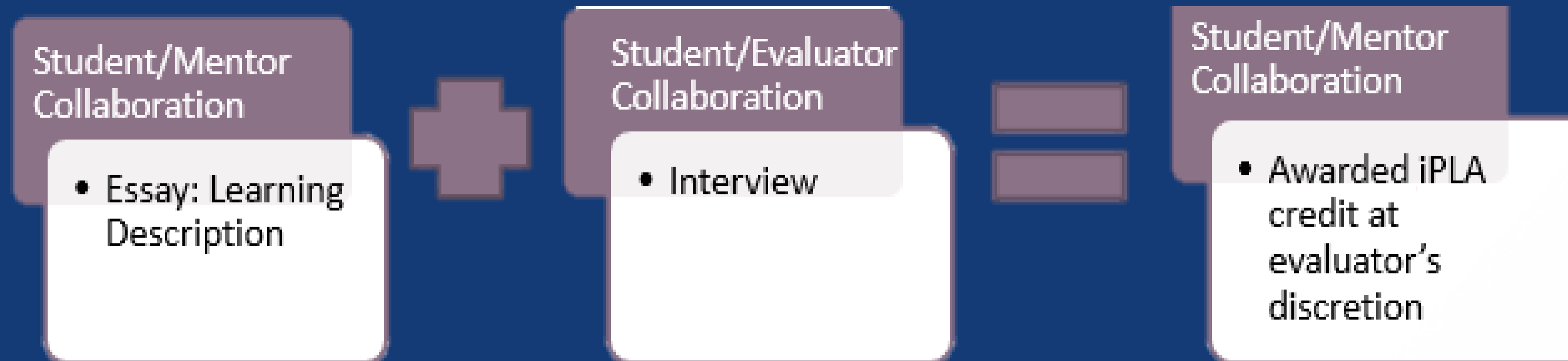

Three courses, including tuition and fees **\$4,520.00** \$3,815.00 NYS

Fourth course, is basically free, 12+ credits **\$4,520.00** \$3,815.00 NYS

- Complete the online admissions application

- Submit proof of high school completion (high school transcript, or picture of diploma, or GED with scores)
- ~~\$50~~ orientation *fee waiver code* **ECPTCCOOS** and receive the *Better Together Scholarship of \$100* in your first term

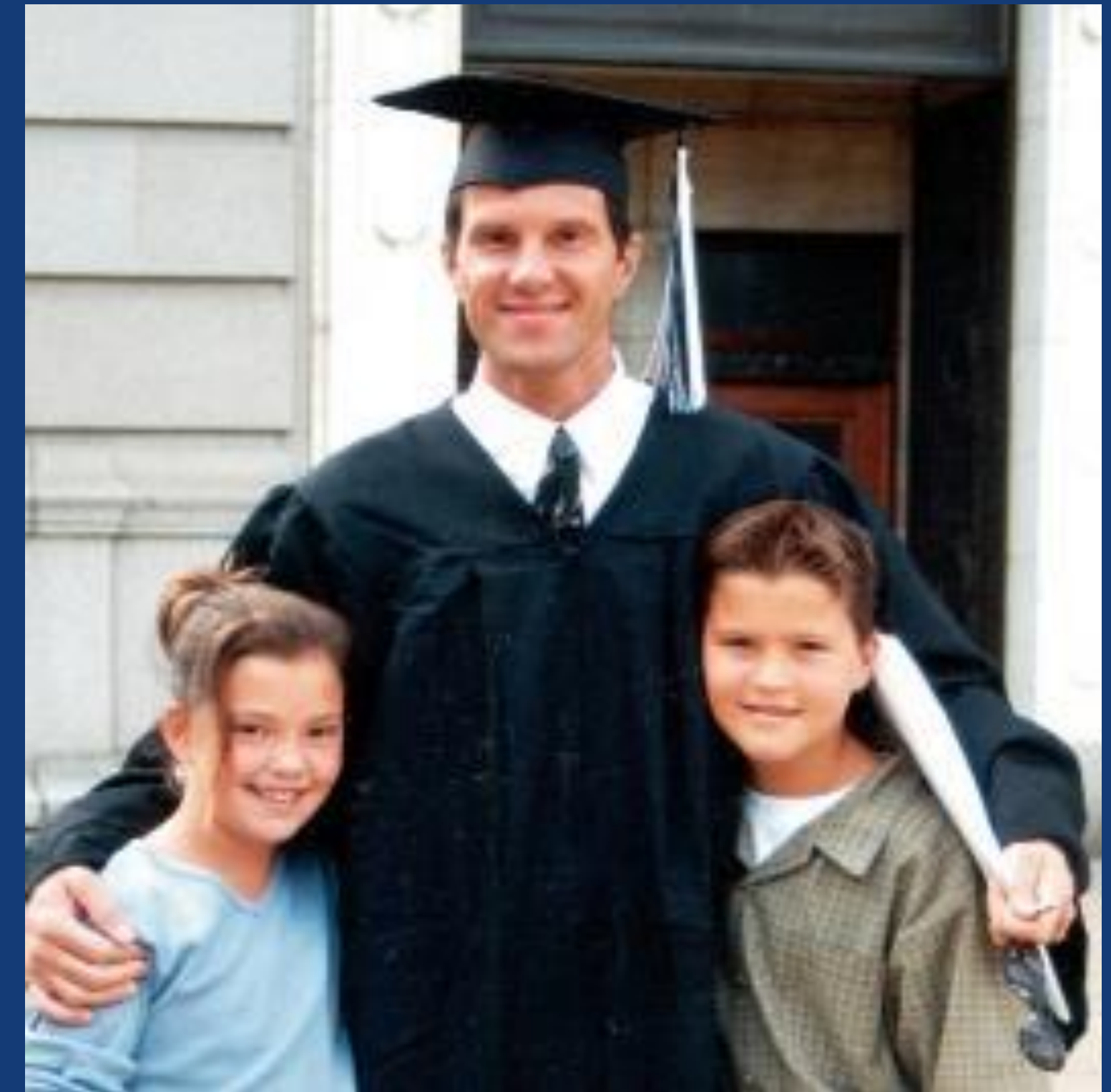
