**Students who complete the Graphic Design certificate can apply those courses to CCV's Design & Media Studies (A.A.) program.**

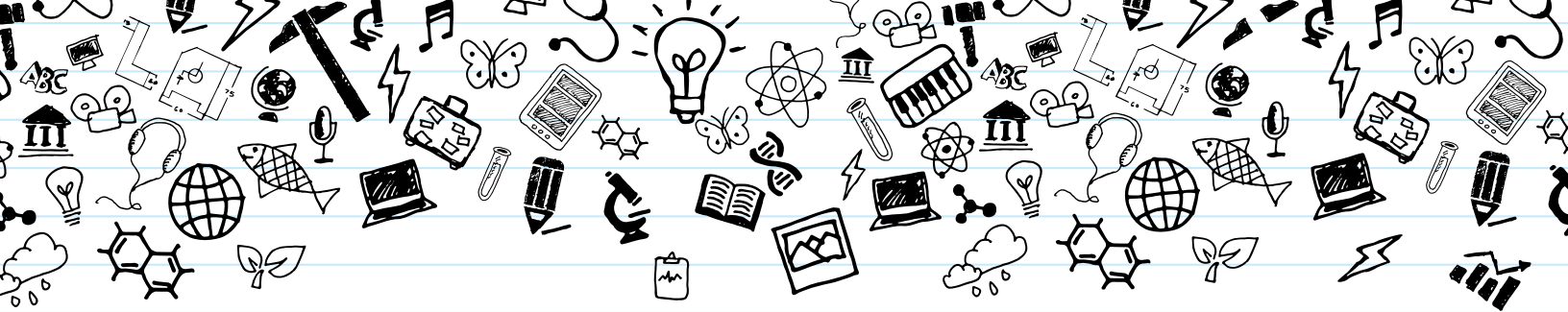

Early College Plus is a **FREE** year of college **PLUS** a **\$1,000 stipend**. If you're a member of the Vermont high school class of 2023, and plan to pursue one of five certificate programs at CCV during your Early College year, you're eligible for an extra \$1,000. You'll also get specialized academic and career advising.

Students considering **Early College Plus** are strongly encouraged to complete 3-6 college credits from **Dual Enrollment** or **Fast Forward** courses prior to enrolling. ART 1210 is a prerequisite course for the Graphic Design certificate and is recommended prior to enrolling in the Digital Media Production certificate.
