

Fresh Start Acknowledgment

The federal Fresh Start initiative restores Title IV financial aid eligibility for borrowers who defaulted on their federal student loans prior to the pandemic payment pause. Once new aid is disbursed to borrowers who qualify under the Fresh Start initiative, the Department of Education will automatically initiate a transfer of the borrowers' defaulted loans to a non-default loan servicer. This transfer will remove the default status of the loans and allow borrowers to remain eligible to receive Title IV aid beyond the Fresh Start period.

To regain Title IV eligibility under the Fresh Start initiative, you must complete the acknowledgment below.

I understand that this transfer may not occur immediately and that I can contact the holder(s) of my defaulted loan(s) to request transfer sooner.
