Student Loan Forgiveness Updates!

If you have Federal Student Loans, here are a couple of important updates!

- 1) Student Loan Repayments have paused until January 2023, when borrowers will need to resume payments.
- 2) If you make under \$125,000 per year, you may qualify for up to \$20,000 in student loan forgiveness. All borrowers with Federal Loans will receive \$10,000 in forgiveness, and those who received Pell Grants will receive an additional \$10,000.
