### Need Firewood?

If you are struggling to heat your home this winter and use firewood as fuel, Wood4Good in Jericho will provide a cord of wood for your household. If you live in Chittenden County, they will deliver it right to you. If not, you can still pick it up!

If you need wood, simply fill out their online form or ask your RC for help! And don't forget:



Fuel Assistance can help pay part of your home heating bills (whether you own or rent) if you are income eligible, and needs to be applied for before applying for Crisis Fuel.



### Free Preventative Care!

If you are uninsured or underinsured and have breasts or a cervix, you may qualify for free preventative care through VT Department of Health's You First Program. You First also Covers healthy lifestyle perks for members 30-64. Members can get heart health screenings and receive benefits like one-on-one health coaching, fitness memberships, nutrition and weight-loss programs, passes to VT State Parks, coupons for local farmers markets –and much more!



### Need Help with your Holiday Budget?

Call your local food shelf to find out if/how they offer holiday food donations like Thanksgiving turkeys!



### Get Assistance with VT's Health Care Options!

Vermont Legal Aid's Health Care Advocate HelpLine is a free resource to help Vermonters solve problems related to health care. They can tell you what free/low-cost programs you may be eligible for and then help you apply, find out what your health plan covers, and provide advice about how to solve billing issues and make complaints.
