Get Assistance with VT's Health Care Options! Vermont Legal Aid's <u>Health Care Advocate</u> HelpLine is a free resource to help Vermonters solve problems related to health care. They can tell you what free/low-cost programs you may be eligible for and then help you apply, find out what your health plan covers, and

memberships, nutrition and weight-loss programs, passes to VT State Parks, coupons for local farmers markets —and much more!
