IN-PERSON APPOINTMENTS



Volunteer Income Tax Assistance – CVOEO – Dial 211

For tax households that make \$60,000 or less, dial 2-1-1 to make a free tax preparation appointment with a Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) volunteer. Appointments are held at the University Mall in South Burlington. More information will be available mid-January.
