Tenants Rights and Resources

Vermont Tenants services are provided by CVOEO's Housing Advocacy team and available to renters anywhere in Vermont. Contact the Hotline at **(802) 864-0099** or email **vttenants@cvoeo.org** with questions about your rights and responsibilities, habitability issues, and other concerns. Advocates provide consultations, referrals, and navigation services. Workshops are also available on tenant rights, responsibilities, and tools and tips for finding/keeping housing. Do I Qualify for 3SquaresVT?

If you are curious about your eligibility for 3SquaresVT (also known as SNAP or food stamps), scan the QR code below to find out if you may be eligible and receive an estimated amount of benefits you could receive. This is not an application to the program, but a general screening tool. Based on the information you give, the screener will calculate your eligibility and explain the calculations behind the result. If you would like help applying for 3Squares or checking your eligibility, reach out to your local Community Action Agency or your Resource Coordinator.



Looking for Parenting Resources?

In-Home Vaccinations Available

Free, in-home vaccination is available from the Vermont Center for Independent Living for anyone who has difficulty getting to or using a community vaccination location, including children. No insurance information will be collected. Entire households including caregivers and friends can be vaccinated at once for COVID (ages 6 months+), Flu (ages 6 months+), and RSV (ages 60+). Call
