VITA Tax Prep with CVOEO

If your household earned less than \$67,000 last year, you can receive free tax assistance through the VITA program through CVOEO. VITA volunteers can help you file your state and federal taxes, Vermont Reters Credits, and Homestead Declarations/Property Tax Credits. Appointments start on February 1st, and you can call to schedule your appointment starting on January 15th.

Income between \$67,000-\$84,000: File online or over the phone.
Income over \$84,000: Online file only.
