- Other people if they now live with you and you provide more than half of their financial support and will continue to provide more than half their support through June 30, 2026.

The provided criteria for “dependent children” or “other persons” match the requirement that family size align with whom the parent could claim as a dependent on a U.S. tax return if the parent were to file a U.S. tax return at the time of a completing the 2025-2026 FAFSA. As a result, the parent should not include any unborn children in the family size.
